Easy Urban Gardens

- *Agastache foeniculum*, anise hyssop
- *Asclepias incarnata* and *A. tuberosa*, rose and butterfly milkweed
- *Monarda punctata* and *fistulosa*, spotted bee balm and wild bergamot
- *Rudbeckia hirta*, black eyed Susan
- *Schizachyrium scoparium* and *Panicum virgatum*, little blue stem and northern switch grass

Shady Sites

- *Dicentra eximia*, woodland bleeding heart
- *Polystichum acrostichoides*, Christmas fern
- *Solidago caesia*, wreath goldenrod

Asters are not weeds!

- *Symphotrichum cordifolium* and *S. laeve*, blue wood and smooth aster

A Better Lawn

- *Carex pensylvanica*, Pennsylvania sedge
- *Fragaria virginiana*, wild strawberry

Fill the Space

- *Rhus aromatica* and *R. copallinum*, fragrant and winged sumac
